UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 9,763,410
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million eight hundred and ninety-three thousand, four hundred and sixty-six (5,893,466). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million eight hundred and sixty-one thousand one hundred and thirty-six (3,861,136), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million and thirty-two thousand, three hundred and thirty persons (2,032,330) as at 11th, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **79,913** compared to the previous day at **62,221** persons vaccinated.

Nairobi County in the lead with 21.6 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 18.9, Kiambu 12.2, Nyandarua 10.1, while Marsabit is the least county with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county



Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received the first Dose (Dose 1) of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county with 35.0% followed by Nyeri at 30.6, Kirinyaga at 23.0, Laikipia 22.4, Kiambu 21.1 and Muranga at 20.3, Marsabit being the least with 1.4, Wajir 1.5, Mandera 1.9 of the population receive dose 1 vaccination.




Table 8 shows the weekly trend of COVID-19 doses administered starting from the first week of March 2021 to the first week of November 2021.
