## **UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE**

## **Background**

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 16,201,670
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose AstraZeneca began on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4<sup>th</sup>
   September 2021, Sinopharm 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2021 and Pfizer on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered Seven million, five hundred and twenty-five thousand, six hundred and eighty-one (7,525,681) Those received first dose or partially vaccinated four million five hundred and ninety-five thousand, and thirty-one (4,595,031), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million, nine hundred and thirty thousand, six hundred and fifty persons (2,930,650) at 3<sup>rd</sup>, December 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday (Friday) is 108,405 compared to the previous day (Thursday) at 113,633 out of the total vaccinated 55,103 received Dose 1, while 53,302 received Dose 2 and JJ vaccine.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county



So far four Million eight hundred and ninety-one thousand, four-hundred and ninety (4,891,490) persons have received at least one dose out of the target population of twenty-seven Million, two hundred and forty-six thousand and thirty-three (27,246,033) =18.0%

Table: 9 Covid -19 Weekly Trends Doses Administered March -1st Week of December 2021




Table 9 above shows the weekly trend of COVID- 19 doses administered starting from the start of the vaccination exercise to date (first week of March 2021 to week one December 2021)
