

MINISTRY OF HEALTH UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 16,201,670
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered Seven million, five hundred and fifty-four thousand, one hundred and forty-nine (7,554,149) Those received first dose or partially vaccinated four million, six hundred and eleven thousand, nine hundred and fifty-eight (4,611,958), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million, nine hundred and forty-two thousand, one hundred and ninety-one persons (2,942,191) at 4th, December 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated during the weekend, (Saturday) is **28,468** compared to the previous day (Friday) at 108,405 out of the total vaccinated **16,927** received Dose 1, while **11,541** received Dose 2 and JJ vaccine.



Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received at least one dose of Covid-19 vaccine (A dose of Johnson and Johnson vaccine and first dose of other vaccines) as at 4th, December 2021. So far four Million nine hundred and fourteen thousand, six-hundred and eight (**4,914,608**) persons have received at least one dose out of the target population of twenty-seven Million, two hundred and forty-six thousand and thirty-three (**27,246,033**) =18.0%


