UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 8,997,810
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th
 September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million six hundred and ninety-one thousand and hundred and fifty (5,691,050). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million eight hundred and eight thousand three hundred and eighty -two (3,808,382), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) one million eight hundred and eighty-two thousand six hundred and sixty- eight persons (1,882,668) as at 8th, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **51,098** compared to the previous day at **15,722** persons vaccinated.

Table 4 above and figure 1.1 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 20.3 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 17.8, Kiambu 11.2, Taita Taveta 9.4, Nyandarua 9.3, Uasin Gishu with 9.1, Kisumu 8.2, Kirinyaga and Mombasa 8.0 respectively. Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county



Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received the first Dose (Dose 1) of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county with 34.7% followed by Kiambu at 30.3, Kirinyaga at 21.9, Kiambu 20.9 and Muranga at 20.0, Marsabit being the least with 1.4, Wajir 1.5, Mandera 1.9 of the population receive dose 1 vaccination.
