UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 8,997,810
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million four hundred and eighty-two thousand and eighty-nine (5,482,089). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million seven hundred and forty-four thousand and seven hundred and ten (3,744,710), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) one million seven hundred and thirty -seven thousand three hundred and seventy-nine persons (1,737,379) as at 3rd, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **54,471** persons compared to the previous day at **49,980** persons vaccinated.

Table 4 above and figure 1.2 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 18.9 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 16.6, Kiambu 10.2, Uasin Gishu with 8.8, Nyandarua 8.6, Kisumu 7.8, Mombasa 7.6 and Muranga 7.5, while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county


