Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 8,997,810
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million five hundred and forty-sixty thousand nine hundred and nine seven (5,546,979). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million seven hundred and sixty-four thousand seven hundred and sixty- seven (3,764,767), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) one million seven hundred and eighty -two thousand two hundred and twelve persons (1,782,212) as at 4th, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **64,890** compared to the previous day at

54,471 persons vaccinated.



Table 4 above and figure 1.2 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 19.3 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 17.0, Kiambu 10.6, Uasin Gishu with and Nyandarua 8.9 respectively, Kisumu 7.9, Mombasa 7.8 and Muranga 7.6, while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.






Table 6, above shows 80.2% of healthcare workers, 51.3% teachers, 15.2% of population above

Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years who have received the first Dose (Dose 1) of COVID-19 Vaccination. Nairobi county with 34.4% of its population receiving dose 1 and Marsabit being the least with 1.4 of the population receive dose 1 vaccination.



The table above shows the weekly doses administered since the start of the COVID 19 vaccination in March 2021 to Week 1 Nov 2021 in descending of frequency and the cumulative line on the secondary axis as percentage of the total doses administered. The highest doses administered was in week 18-24 October 2021 and the lowest was weeks of March 2021.
