## **UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE**

## Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 8,997,810
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose AstraZeneca began on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021, Sinopharm 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2021 and Pfizer on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million six hundred and eleven thousand Seven hundred and seventy-two (5,611,772). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million seven hundred and eighty-two thousand six hundred and fifty- nine (3,782,659), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) one million eight hundred and twenty-nine thousand eleven hundred and thirteen persons (1,829,113) as at 5<sup>th</sup>, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **64,793** compared to the previous day at **64,890** persons vaccinated.

Table 2 and table 3 shows the cumulative number of persons who received dose 1 (partially vaccinated and dose 2 (Fully Vaccinated) respectively by gender

Table 4 above and figure 1.1 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 19.7 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 17.4, Kiambu 10.9, Nyandarua 9.2, Uasin Gishu with 9.0, Kisumu 8.1 and Mombasa 7.9 while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county




