Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 8,997,810
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered five million six hundred and twenty-four thousand two hundred and thirty (5,624,230). Those received first dose or partially vaccinated three million seven hundred and eighty-seven thousand two hundred and eleven (3,787,211), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) one million eight hundred and thirty-seven thousand and nineteen persons (1,837,019) as at 6th, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday is **12,458** compared to the previous day at

64,793 persons vaccinated.




Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county

Table 4 above and figure 1.1 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 19.8 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 17.4, Kiambu 10.9, Nyandarua 9.2, Uasin Gishu with 9.0, Kisumu 8.1 and Mombasa 7.9 while, Mandera, Wajir and Marsabit are the least counties with less than 1% of the population fully vaccinated.


