PRESS STATEMENT

VACCINATION CAMPAIGN:

As of October 17th 2021, a total of **4,520,753** vaccines had so far been administered across the country. Of these, **3,303,782** were partially vaccinated while those fully vaccinated were **1,216,971**.

The uptake of the second dose among those who received their first dose was at **35.3**%. Proportion of adults fully vaccinated was **4.5**%. The Government is working towards vaccinating a targeted population of **27,246,033**.

The table below shows the proportion of those above 18 years who are partially vaccinated in respective counties. Nairobi County is the highest with **31.8%** of its population receiving the first dose while Marsabit County is the least with **1.4%**.

The table below shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with **14.4%** of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri County **11.4%**, Kiambu **7.0%**, Uasin Gishu with **6.8%**, Nyandarua **5.8%** and Kisumu **5.4%**, Mombasa **5.1%** and Laikipia **5.0%**, while Lamu, Turkana, Mandera, Wajir Garissa, Tana River and Marsabit are the least with less than **1%** of their population fully vaccinated.

On the Covid-19 situation today **33** people have tested positive for the disease, from a sample size of **3,530** tested in the last 24 hours. The positivity rate is now at **0.9%**. From the cases **28** are Kenyans while **5** are foreigners. **17** males while **16** are females. The youngest is a **two-month-old child** while the oldest is **98** years. Total confirmed positive cases are now **252,066** and cumulative tests so far conducted are **2,642,637**.

In terms of **County** distribution; Nairobi **7**, Machakos **4**, Mombasa **4**, Baringo **2**, Kericho **2**, Kiambu **2**, Murang'a **2**, Turkana **2**, Bomet **1**, Busia **1**, Elgeyo Marakwet **1**, Kitui **1**, Makueni **1**, Nakuru **1**, Narok **1** and Garissa **1**.

Distribution of positive cases by age is as follows; 0-9 years (3), 10-19 years (3), 20-29 years (6), 30-39 (4), 40-49 (1), 50-59 (4), 60 years and above (12).

Today **93** patients have recovered from the disease with **77** from the Home-Based Isolation and Care program while **16** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Total recoveries now stand at **245,347** of whom **198,208** are from the Home-Based Care and Isolation program, while **47,139** are from various health facilities countrywide.

Unfortunately, **one** patient has succumbed to the disease, **one** being a late death reported after conducting facility audit records in the month of October 2021. This now pushes the cumulative deaths to **5,224**. Our sincere condolences to the families and those that have lost their loved ones.

New deaths by age; 0-9 years (0), 10-19 years (0), 20-29 (0), 30-39 years (0), 40-49 years (0), 50-59 years (1), 60 years and above (0).

Cumulative deaths by age; 0-9 years **(58)**, 10-19 years **(38)**, 20-29 **(140)**, 30-39 years **(377)**, 40-49 years **(604)**, 50-59 years **(982)** 60 years and above **(3,025)**.

A total of **587** patients are currently admitted in various health facilities countrywide, while **1,531** are under the Home-Based Isolation and Care program. **30** patients are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), **19** of whom are on ventilatory support and **11** on supplemental oxygen. **No** patient is under observation.

Another **173** patients are separately on supplemental oxygen with **all** of them being in the General wards. **No** patient is in the High Dependency Units (HDU).
