UPDATES ON COVID-19 VACCINATION EXERCISE

Background

- Total Covid-19 Vaccines Received to date- 10,704,690
- 1st dose Covid -19 vaccinations with AstraZeneca began on 5th March 2021, Country vaccinations started on week of 8th March 2021
- Administration of 2nd Dose AstraZeneca began on 28th May 2021.
- Vaccination with Moderna started on 24th August 2021, Johnson and Johnson 4th
 September 2021, Sinopharm 22nd September 2021 and Pfizer on 6th October 2021

Table 1 above shows the current vaccination status. Total doses administered Six million, five hundred and ninety-seven thousand, five hundred and ninety-seven (6,597,597) Those received first dose or partially vaccinated four million and eighty-seven thousand, three hundred and seventeen (4,087,317), and the fully vaccinated (one dose of JJ and Second dose of the other vaccines) two million, five hundred and ten thousand, two hundred and eighty persons (2,510,280) as at 23rd, November 2021.

The number of persons vaccinated yesterday (Tuesday) is 103,506 compared to the previous day (Monday) at 95,511, out of the total vaccinated 53,506 received Dose 1, while 50,000 received Dose 2 and JJ vaccine.

Table 4 above and figure 1.1 below, shows the total county cumulative trends and proportion of fully vaccinated. Nairobi County in the lead with 25.8 of the population fully vaccinated followed by Nyeri county 20.7, Kiambu 15.4, Laikipia 12.6. Taita Taveta 12.3, Nyandarua 11.5, Uasin Gishu and Muranga 11.0, Kirinyaga 10.4 and Kisumu 10.1. While Garissa, Wajir, Tana River, Turkana, West Pokot, Mandera and Marsabit with less than 2% of the population fully vaccinated

Figure 1.1 Proportion of fully vaccinated by county



Table 7 above shows the proportion of the above 18 years' population who have received the first Dose (Dose 1) of COVID-19 Vaccination is at 15.0. Nairobi county with 36.4, followed by Nyeri at 31.6, Kirinyaga and Laikipia at 23.8, Kiambu 22.2, Muranga at 21.4, Taita Taveta 20.9 and Nyandarua 20.1, Marsabit and Wajir being the least with 1.5, Mandera 1.9 of the population received dose 1 vaccination.




Table 8 shows the weekly trend of COVID-19 doses administered starting from the start of the vaccination exercise to date (first week of March 2021 to week four of November 2021)
